Martha sent an article about Sudden Oak Death fungus to the members of this committee. She explained that the DNR has investigated this issue and have found that there have been many rhododendrons at the Walmart garden stores are infected with this disease. And if infected bushes are planted near oak trees, they can pass the disease to the oak tree.
