New Business

- The Police department will continue looking at VRBO etc. for rental violations.
- Chief Sulkowski presented a proposal for body cameras from the BODYWORN by UTILITY company. This new technology includes redacting capabilities. The initial cost would be \$15,260 per year. The equipment is free and any of the on going charges would be for software. The company claims storage in the Cloud would be free.
- Chief Sulkowski also discussed cameras at all 4 town entrances that could read license plates as cars entered the town.
- Chief Sulkowski informed the Commission that 2 squad cars need to be replaced in 2020.
