

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LONG BEACH TOWN COUNCIL
AMENDING PORTIONS OF THE TEXT OF
THE ZONING CODE OF THE TOWN OF LONG BEACH, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Long Beach Town Council on June 10, 2002, adopted a Zoning Code of the Town of Long Beach, LaPorte County, Indiana which is located at Chapter 154 of the Long Beach Town Code; and

WHEREAS, the Long Beach Advisory Plan Commission has initiated an amendment to the text portion of the Zoning Code in order to address sections that are duplicative and conflicting with certain provisions of Chapters 150 and 151 of the Long Beach Town Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held before the Town of Long Beach Advisory Plan Commission, which has certified its proposal to amend the text of the Zoning Code to the Long Beach Town Council; and

WHEREAS, notice has been given in accordance with Indiana Code of all proceedings concerning this text amendment to the Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, the Long Beach Town Council concurs with its Advisory Plan Commission and accepts its proposal to amend the text of the Zoning Code;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Long Beach Town Council as follows:

SECTION 1: That the following Sections of Chapter 154 shall be deleted from the Zoning Code of the Town of Long Beach:

154.145- Office of the Building Commissioner

154.146- Duties of the Building Commissioner

154.147- Qualifications of a Building Inspector and Electrical Inspector

154.148- Conflict of Interest with Role of Building Commissioner or Inspector

154.156- Development Plan Required with Application for Improvement Location Permit

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption as provided by law.




