

Long Beach Street Commission Minutes
Wednesday March 21, 2018

Members present: Tom Dolph, Brian Hogan, Jane Neulieb, Dan Tannas
Meeting called to order at 5:34 PM

Mr. Dolph reported the following:

Kubota utility vehicle requires repairs to the drive system. This will be contracted to Riggs Power Equipment in Laporte. Approximate cost \$1500

Spring leaf pickup will be coordinated with Dan Healy, and a proposal will be presented to the April Town Council meeting. Anticipated dates will be one week only, the week of April 23rd.

Adequate salt has been ordered for 2018-2019. 650 tons should meet Long Beach needs. Trail Creek and Duneland Beach have been notified that Long Beach will no longer supply their salt.

RE: 1636 Lakeshore Drive: The town's drainage pipe appears to cross the homeowner's property. As soon as weather permits, street department will address the issue. The most likely solution will be to block off the pipe and re-route drainage at or near Stop 17. The department is continues to try to make a permanent repair which will be satisfactory to the property owner.

RE: part of the Houck property adjacent to Moore Road: The Department has cleaned out two dry wells at this location and will monitor the drainage and erosion through the spring to make sure the situation is improved.

Haas and Associates will provide the Department with a pavement status report which can then be used to prioritize pavement projects in Long Beach.

The Street Department concurs with the Parks Department that improvements on the beach stops are needed. Projects have been proposed to improve and update Stops 22 and 26. Mr. Dolph continues to work with Parks Department committees and has suggested safe, practical alternatives to assure proper drainage and still accommodate construction and improvements.

The damaged fence at the west side of the tennis courts may present a safety hazard and needs to be repaired. The Department will locate a contractor who can schedule and complete the work.
