# Long Beach Street Commission Minutes Wednesday May 17, 2017

Present: Members Tom Dolph, Brian Hogan, Jane Neulieb, Dan Tannas

Meeting called to order at 5:30 PM. Previous minutes approved

Agenda Items:

## Equipment status:

Mr. Dolph presented bids on a new leaf-pickup machine. After review and discussion, the commission recommends purchase of the machine from Brown Equipment Company. Commission recommendation and the bid will be presented to Town Council for action at their June meeting.

The street sweeping machine continues to function normally. Debris removal, mainly from oak trees, should be completed on or about June 1 depending on weather.

### Paving:

Resurfacing of the Town Center parking lot is recommended. Mr. Dolph will obtain prices and make a proposal at the June Town Council meeting if funding is available.

No heavy equipment access permits were issued for Stop 24.

No street cut permits were issued.

Spring leaf pickup has been completed on time with no problems.

### Street drainage:

Work is in progress. Some catch basins may need to be replaced with improved designs.

#### Beach stops:

Residents have requested improved access to the beach at Stop 19. Commission members visited Stop 19 to evaluate access. The commission recommends no change:

- Access to the beach is adequate and comparable to other areas, e.g. Stops 18 and
  20
- Dune grass and natural vegetation should not be disturbed
- Natural contours of the beach/sand should not be excavated
- Excavation at the stop cannot be done without affecting adjacent properties Eventually the Town may need to provide ADA-compliant access to a designated beach stop.

A working group of residents suggests improvements to Stop 23, including a revised drainage cap for the catch-basin and five-foot wide steps. The street department will assist with this project once funding is available and a detailed plan is submitted. The commission recommends construction be scheduled to avoid peak activity time of June-July-August.

Mr. Dolph will address the need for an additional railing at Stop 24, and accumulating dead grass/vegetation at Stop 22.

Street Department personnel will attend training for mosquito spraying, which should start in the next week. Normal spraying days will be Mondays, Wednesdays, and Sundays.

Beach cleanup is scheduled for the weekend of June 3-4. Trash toters should be placed at stops prior to that weekend.
