## Long beach Street Commission Minutes Wednesday April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017

Present: Commission members Tom Dolph, Brian Hogan, Dan Tannas

Meeting called to order at 5:30 PM. March meeting was canceled, so no minutes were approved.

## Agenda items:

Street drainage: Mr. Dolph reported that drainage problems continue to be prioritized depending on the potential for property damage and budget constraints. The drywell at 2930 Lothair is being repaired which should resolve flooding problems at that location. A drain under the street near Stop 20 appears to be causing problems and these will be addressed soon.

Paving: The department will try to observe previous budgetary limitations of \$100,000. Lakeshore Drive paving will await completion of road cuts related to house construction. Bidding will take place in August with the objective of completion in September.

Leaf Pickup/leaf machine: Spring leaf cleanup will take place beginning Monday April 24<sup>th</sup>. There will be one sweep from Stop 13 to Stop 31. Good weather has allowed residents adequate time to get ready.

Present equipment appears to be adequate for the spring cleanup. However, a new machine will be needed by fall 2017. The Street Commission awaits legal guidance and action by the Town Council to proceed with a purchase. Equipment needs to be ordered in May to assure delivery by fall pickup dates.

Once the Town Council approves, purchase paperwork can be completed within a week.

Other business: Mr. Dolph reports that due to the mild winter the town still has 325 tons of salt on hand. It is expected that the vendor will once again store our excess for a fee of \$10 per ton, and that bill should be forthcoming. Mr. Dolph will order adequate salt for next winter's anticipated needs.

The Park Board has purchased a new backstop for the ball diamond at the town center park. The Street Department will remove the old one and install the new one.

The Street Department cleaned up minor tree damage and fallen limbs after recent wind storms and thunderstorms.
