Long Beach Street Commission Minutes Wednesday September 19.2018 5:30 PM

Mr. Dolph presented plans for drainage work at the Houck property bordering Moore Road. The repair is regarded as urgent due to continual erosion onto the homeowner's property. Prior to work taking place, the following need to be addressed:

- Coordinate with Michigan City due to proximity to sanitary sewers
- Request a review of the engineering plans by Haas and Associates
- Obtain bids for the work and determine the specific funding source
- Contract the paving repair to Moore Road once the project is completed

The objective is to resolve this problem more permanently as temporary measures such as gravel fill have been ineffective.

Mr. Dolph presented plans for drainage improvements at Stops 22 and 26 (previously approved by the building commission). The Street Department will be responsible for curbing and paving adjacent to the stops; the Parks department will be responsible for stairway and deck structures.

Mr. Dolph will forward revised contracts for leaf pick-up and removal/disposal to commission members for review. The intent is for the contractor to provide a third truck for removal, with work scheduled on or about October 22 through November 5.

Grant application for paving is in progress and should be completed on schedule.

Repair/maintenance work on the town truck has been completed by Lindco Equipment in Merrilville.

Removal of all dead trees on right-of-way which present a safety hazard has been completed.

Permits for were approved for the following:

Placement of a utility pole at 2756 Floral Trail

Comcast roadcuts at 1603, 1605, and 2310 Lakeshore Drive
