Long Beach Street Commission Minutes Wednesday April 18, 2018

Mr. Dolph reported the following:

Planning to improve the beach stops continues and is coordinated with the Parks Department. Updates and improvements are planned at Stops 22, 26, and possibly others. Paving, drainage, and utility expenses will be paid by the Street Department; stairways, decks, and other structures will be paid by the Parks Department; engineering expenses (hourly fees) will be shared by the two departments.

Curbing/concrete work at stop 19 will be revised to improve drainage, divert runoff, and minimize water damage to stairs and boardwalk. The work will be contracted pending an engineering review.

Street Department will cap the town's drain pipe at Stop 17 and re-route drainage at that location.

Until demolition and grading is completed at Stop 24, the Street Department will be unable to grant beach access for construction equipment. After work is completed, access will depend on beach conditions and weather.

Leaf pickup will proceed as planned the week of April 23rd. Property owners are reminded that large sticks and branches cannot be picked up by the equipment. Removal of such debris is the responsibility of the property owners.

Street Department will repair the damaged fence at the tennis courts.

The pavement assessment has been completed. After review of the report from Haas and Associates, the plan will be presented to the Town Council at the May 14th meeting to continue the contracting process.
