

TOWN OF LONG BEACH
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING @ Town Hall
and via Zoom
September 26, 2022
7:00 PM

Council members John Wall, Mary Lou McFadden, and Mike Johnstone, participated in-person; John Kocher and Bob Lemay attended online this evening. Police Chief Mark Swistek, Attorney Chris Willoughby of Braje, Nelson & Janes, ALCO and Marilyn Jones & Associates were in house. Zoom attendees were Clerk-Treasurer Tim Perry, Deanna Carlson, Building Commissioner Larry Wall, and resident Zafar Rizvi.

After the **Pledge of Allegiance**, Bob Lemay called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and announced roll call voting this evening.

The **Floodplain Ordinance #2022-12: Adopting Updated FEMA Floodplain Management Measures and Restating Title XV, Chapter 155 in its Entirety** was discussed for adoption. The FEMA deadline down state is September 29, 2022. 1st read by J. Wall; second by McFadden approved 5 – 0. Kocher motions to suspend the rules and adopt the ordinance; second by McFadden; approved 5 – 0. Motion by Wall to approved on 2nd read; second by McFadden. Ordinance passes 5 – 0. Attorney Willoughby will get all council signatures and send down state for approval.

Sergeant James Schooley presents a salary increase proposal for the Police Department and gives a hand out to the council (copy on file). Officer Sightes also addressed the council about the proposal. It proposes salary increases based on LIT funds the town will be receiving in 2023. Wall suggests more information regarding neighboring communities' departments. The council will discuss more on the subject at their October 10th meeting.

There were no public comments.

Motion and second to adjourn by McFadden and Wall, approved 4-1. (Lemay could not vote, no video)
Meeting adjourned at 8:45 PM.
