

TOWN OF LONG BEACH
COUNCIL -PUBLIC HEARING
MONDAY, MARCH 1, 2021
6:00 PM

Participating and / or viewing this Zoom Public Hearing were about 15 + people including all five council members, Lemay, Johnstone, McFadden, J. Wall, and Kocher; town attorney Willoughby, C-T de Funiak, Marilyn Jones & Assoc. with court reporter Lempa, Karl Cender, Laurel Kuczynski of the LB Water Board, Deanna Carlson, and some town residents.

After the pledge of allegiance Lemay announced the reason for tonight's public hearing- to discuss and repeal a current town ordinance and to discuss and approve a new ordinance.

Lemay stated the town has paid approximately \$30,000 a year to the LB Water Department for hydrants and piping. The new ordinance aims to repeal the current rental fee ordinance currently on the town's books.

Lemay introduced **Ordinance #2021-01: An Ordinance to Repeal Ordinance No. 0602 (Rental of Fire Hydrants by the Town)**. He opened the public hearing portion where there were no comments in favor nor against this ordinance at which time that portion was closed and a vote of 5 – 0 approved the consideration of the ordinance. Lemay motioned to suspend the rules and consider the ordinance on 2nd reading title only; second by Mary Lou, 5 – 0. All were in favor of the ordinance and it was approved unanimously.

Lemay then introduced **Ordinance #2021-02: An Ordinance to Amend the Water Rates and Charges for the Use of the Services Rendered by the Town of Long Beach Water Department**

The public hearing portion of this meeting brought forth no comments for or against the ordinance so the public hearing was closed by 5 – 0 vote. A motion to consider the ordinance on 1st reading; suspend the rules, and again consider the ordinance by 2nd reading title only was presented by McFadden and seconded by Kocher; approved 5 – 0. The ordinance was approved with a unanimous vote 5 – 0.

Lemay requested that de Funiak send "snail mail" mailings to residents of the new ordinance. He will work with the Water Board to get this done.

Motion to adjourn by McFadden; second by Johnstone. Adjourned at 6:12 PM
